



- WHAT:** The International REACH (Recognizing Excellence and ACHievement) Scholarship sponsored by Chevron and administered by the Institute of International Education and Scholarship Management Services.
- WHO:** Children and child dependents of regular employees of Chevron Corporation and its wholly-owned subsidiaries and Chevron employees seconded to affiliates, joint ventures, etc.
- FOR:** Full-time undergraduate study at colleges, universities, and vocational-technical schools.
- WHERE:** The scholarship may be used for study in any country.
- HOW MUCH:** Scholarships will range from US\$500 to \$2,500. The program is intended to assist with college expenses—not cover the full amount.
- HOW LONG:** Scholarships and one-time honorariums will be awarded each year. Scholarship awards may be renewed for up to three additional years or until a first degree or certificate is earned, whichever occurs first. One-time honorarium awards of \$1,000 are non-renewable.
- WHEN:** Deadline for submitting applications for the 2009-2010 academic year is January 15, 2009.
- HOW:** Interested students must complete the application form and submit it, along with a complete transcript of grades for the last four years of schooling, to the appropriate administrator:
