As the year comes to a close, we'd like to remind you of the Chevron Humankind program and encourage you to request matching dollars for your contributions and volunteer hours, up to \$2,000 annually. This program is Chevron's way of supporting the causes you care about. Here's how:

- **Give directly to a cause and request a match.** This includes checks, stocks, mutual funds or donor advised funds. There may be tax benefits contributing your personal stock. Your financial advisor can provide complete information.
- **Request a grant for volunteer service.** Volunteer 20 hours for a single cause and request a \$500 grant. You can apply for two grants of \$500 per calendar year. They can be for the same or different organizations.

New Deadline for Matching and Volunteer Grants

We've extended the deadline for matching and volunteer grant requests to **Jan. 31, 2012**. Request matching and volunteer grants for anything done in 2011, even if it was months ago.
