After the tour, there will be a reception and dinner at the refinery's recreation clubhouse.

At the conclusion of the AM, we will install our new CRA president, Brad McCullough. He will conduct the President's Planning Meeting later that afternoon.

I'm looking forward to seeing all of you again at the AM. I hope you can make it.

We all need to have a positive attitude in restarting. Racial injustice, a year in reflection

In response to a convergence of events that included the spread of COVID-19, an economic downturn that led to massive unemployment and social unrest growing out of the death of George Floyd and other Black Americans in the United States, we made a commitment to address barriers to racial equity.

Our commitment started by listening. Last summer, Chevron employees and leaders shared their emotions, perspectives and vulnerabilities on internal dialogue platforms, in town halls, and in sponsored forums organized by our Black Employee Network. We heard employees express experiences and painful events and engaged in important discussions on race that were often uncomfortable.

Our approach to addressing barriers to equity also included a \$15 million pledge to support Black employees and the Black community. This commitment is based on four strategic pillars: education, job creation, talent and leadership development, and community and small business partnerships.

Chevron brands its first CNG retail site

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. announced the Allied Clean Fuels Plaza retail station in Napa, California, has been rebranded as its first compressed natural gas (CNG) site. Chevron expects to rebrand or open more than 30 CNG sites by 2025.

The announcement underscores Chevron's commitment to providing affordable, reliable and evercleaner energy by increasing renewables and offsets in support of our business. It also builds on Chevron's previously announced investments, such as ventures with California Bioenergy and Brightmark and our Adopt-a-Port initiative with Clean Energy Fuels, to market renewable natural gas for use in vehicles operating on CNG.

"We are excited to announce our first Chevron-branded CNG station," said Mike Vomund, Chevron vice president of Fuels, Americas Fuel & Lubricants. "CNG is part of the portfolio of technologies and solutions Chevron is investing in to reduce the carbon intensity of our products and operations. And our move into the retail CNG space strengthens our commitment to leverage the entire value chain in producing renewable natural gas and offering it to California drivers."

Chevron Advocacy Network (CAN)

This last year has been a year of immense change, but Chevron's continued commitment to our energy transition strategy and actions is one area that remains unchanged. At Chevron, we believe the future of energy is lower carbon. To help with this energy transition, Chevron has launched an <u>Energy Transition website</u>, which details our approach and provides resources on Chevron's strategy for a lower-carbon future.

To achieve our energy transition goals, our approach is centered on actions and investments in three core areas where we believe we can deliver measurable progress for today and the future by:

By mid-pandemic an estimated 41 percent of U.S. adults - about 105 million people - had postponed in-person medical care, be it routine or emergency, according to the CDC. Elective surgeries were mostly shut down, routine health screenings had dropped by more than half, and millions of people simply stayed away from doctors' offices. Here's what to ask yourself if you, too, avoided routine care this past year.
